This Independent Contractor position averages 15 hours per week, for a period of up to 15 weeks @ \$30 hourly. Hours are flexible, with regularly scheduled online meetings with Z Puppets' Creative Directors.

- Research national, regional, state and local funding sources for creating and expanding virtual and live programming of Z Puppets' Cherokee Language Revitalization Initiative.
- Create database and analyze potential of each source.
- Outline a Development Calendar spreadsheet, with funding requirements and application details.
- Research national, regional, state and local presenters and platforms for booking virtual and live programs.
- Develop a spreadsheet of potential venues including contact information, booking profiles and timeline.
- Assist in preparing materials and drafting proposals and pitches.
- Initiating contact and follow ups with potential funders and presenters.
